Subject: Education: Proposed Building Leadership Program Changes

Description:

Changes in the Building Leadership Program:

The Department of Education has reviewed their 36 hour graduate program in building leadership and recommends the following changes which update the knowledge and skills needed for building administrators. The changes proposed would 1). Replace the required advanced educational psychology course with a technology course. 2) Replace a classroom reading instruction class with a special education course on learning and behavior problems. Rationale: These changes update the needs expressed by the professional community as well as those required by the KSDE state standards for building administrators. The needs include additional knowledge and background in the area of technology and special education.
