# Jennifer Hastert

Washburn tennis head coach Jennifer Hastert enters her ninth full season in charge of the Washburn tennis program. The two-time All-American will coach her final season at Washburn as she will have her second child this summer.

Hastert has coached the Ichabods to two MIAA championships in the last two years and she has led both teams to the NCAA tournament a combined 11 times.

Last year the Ichabods won the MIAA championship and hosted the first two rounds of the NCAA tournament. They won those two matches and advanced to the national quarterfinals and finished with an 18-3 record.

The Lady Blues won their first 19 matches last year before falling in the MIAA tournament title dual. They also hosted the first two rounds of the NCAA tournament and finished with a 20-2 record.

In 2005-06 Hastert coached the men's team to its first MIAA championship with a 17-6 record and both teams advanced to the NCAA region tournament.

In her eight seasons at Washburn she has led the women's team to two MIAA championships and seven NCAA tournament appearances with a 150-44-1 dual record. She has led the men's team to four NCAA tournament appearances, two MIAA titles and a 101-67 dual record. In 2004, Hastert was named women's MIAA and North Central

Region coach of the year after she coached the team to its first-ever NCAA national tournament appearance.

The Ichabods also reached the NCAA national tournament that year, making Washburn one of only four schools to have both its men's and women's teams reach the Sweet 16.

Hastert played at Washburn from 1991 to 1993 and 1995 to 1996 and had a stellar Washburn career, finishing with three All-America awards and four MIAA championships. In her three campaigns at Washburn, she finished 64-9 in singles and 59-11 in doubles.

Following her freshman season, Hastert was named an NCAA Division II All-American and the Volvo Midwest Tennis Rookie of the Year. Her sophomore season she finished in second at No. 1 singles and third at No. 1 doubles during the MIAA championship tournament and had her second All-America distinction.

After transferring to Drake University her junior season, she returned to Washburn for her senior year during the 1995-96 season after sitting out a season. Hastert returned to win the MIAA No. 1 singles and No. 1 doubles championships.

During her playing career, she was ranked as high as No. 4 in the nation in singles and No. 7 in doubles with partner Jill Bernhardt. Hastert's postseason awards included an

NCAA Division II All-America honor and she was a two-time MIAA player of the week.

Prior to her coaching appointment, Hastert worked at Hallbrook Country Club in Leawood, Kan., as the associate junior development professional directing junior and adult clinics since 1998.

Hastert and her husband Steven live in Topeka with their son, Noah, who was born Dec. 16, 2003.



### Julie Huyberechts • Assistant Coach • 1st Year

After finishing her four-year career as a tennis player at Washburn, Julie Huyberechts begins her first season as an assistant coach this year.

Huyberechts was an eight-time all-MIAA honoree, earning awards in singles four times and doubles four times. She finished her time as Washburn's

career leader in singles wins with 98. She also holds the school record with 69 wins at No. 2 singles and her 98-26 record gave her a .790 winning percentage, good enough for sixth best in school history.



### Tyler Kinder • Assistant Coach • 1st Year

Tyler Kinder begins his first year as an assistant coach after playing for the Ichabods from 2002-06.

Kinder finished eighth in career singles wins with 48 and he holds the school record with 34 wins at No. 4 singles.

Kinder won seven all-MIAA awards, receiving

the honor in singles four times and doubles three times.

Kinder finished with a 48-31 singles record and 54-37 doubles record.
