Subject: Computers for CAMP's training project.

Get me the names of the major government contractors in the Seattle Area. Make sure you include the Defense Contractors.

Why defense contractors in particular. Because they must constantly up-grade, their computer hard ware and soft ware, to stay abreast, ^{IF} not ahead of national defense and national security requirements. Therefore, its not uncommon for these contractors to give away new to nearly new computers and boxes upon boxes of soft ware. It could be that there one to several such defense contractor in the Seattle Area, that need to ride themselves of such items at this very moment.

If you'll get me the names of the companies in question, I'll do my part to get CAMP both the computers and the soft ware you need to run your training program.
