

On July 28, 2003 at 11:45 am, representatives for the United States Government received a SMARTFaith application to federal program

This proposal defines faith from an American perspective, reflecting a "confident assurance that something America needs can indeed happen."

The "Smart States Region" is introduced to demonstrate the potential for maximizing human effort through an increased understanding of technology as it relates to basic human needs.

SMARTFaith is designed to reduce the dependence on federal government by persons of faith. It is a long-term solution requiring the active participation of individuals, organizations, institutions, agencies who support the ideal of "one nation under God... indivisible with liberty and justice for all

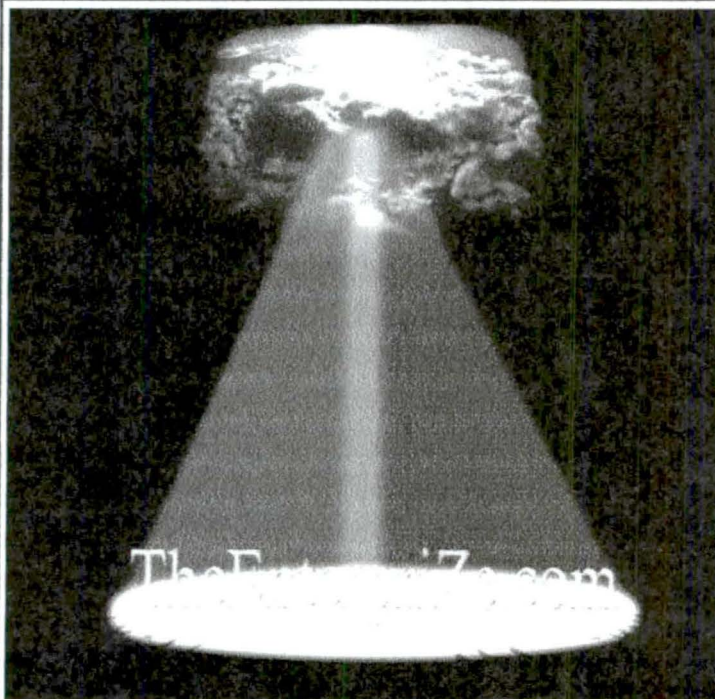

- **Sub-Award Qualification:** SMARTFaith Sub-Awards, up to \$20,000, are determined through a competitive peer review. Participation requires a minimum of three completed applications to
- **Consultants:** Are contracted to support technical assistance missions. They might also serve as account executives that assist local mentors in accessing SMARTFaith resources.
- **GrandMentors:** GrandMentors are senior citizens identified as members of a WHOLE VILLAGE on an application to
  - A GrandMentor, age 65 or older, with computer skills and Internet access can qualify for one of six budgeted volunteer positions. Stipends are available for authorized expenses.
- **Scholarship:** An applicant to THE ANNUAL YOUTH ACHIEVEMENT AWARDS qualifies for one of ten \$1000 scholarships awarded by The J.D. and Laurena Walker Foundation. Selection criteria is based on financial need and academic achievement.
