Addressing George Washington, President of the
Constitutional Convention, Ben Franklin declared, on June
28, 1787:

the small progress we have made after four or five weeks' close attendance and continued reasonings with each other, our different sentiments in almost every question, several of the last producing as many no's as aye's is, methinks, a melancholy proof of the imperfection of the human understanding . . . In this situation of this Assembly, groping as it were in the dark to find political truth, and scarce able to distinguish it would present it to us, how has it happened, sir, that we have not hitherto once thought of humbly applying to the Father of Lights to illuminate our understanding? In the beginning of the contest with Great Britain when we were sensible of danger, we had daily prayer in this room for the divine protection. Our prayers, sir, were heard, and they were graciously answered. . . . And have we now forgotten that powerful Friend? Or do we imagine we no longer need His assistance?

I have lived, sir, a long time. And the longer I live, the more convincing proofs I see of this truth, that God governs in the affairs of men. And if a sparrow cannot fall to the ground without His notice, is it probable that an empire can rise without His aid? We have been assured, sir, in the sacred writing, that "except the Lord build the house, they labor in vain that build it."
