We are writing to you regarding our son/and brother James L. Doss #33628, who is an inmate at Mc Neil Island Federal Penitentiary. Jimmy appeared before the Parole Board on June 21, 1971. The results of his appearance was that he should return again in June of 1973.

It is our concern that all of the information regarding Jimmy's Parole Program was not present in his folder at the time he was interviewed or even before the decision was made on his parole.

We are asking for consideration for the above mentioned reason and also the unusual hardships that our family is now facing.

Jimmy has also been offered a very good educational opportunity through one of the local Universities here in Los Angeles. That information was among the information that apparently arrived too late to be considered by the Board.

I am asking for a Washington review as soon as possible according to Board rules.
